They say that you never get a second chance to make a first impression. Our Gutswein serve as that calling card, introducing the elegance and sense of place for which our Rheinhessen estate is known. The grapes are all grown in our own vineyards, cultivated bio-dynamically and tended by hand. They are exceptionally food friendly wines both in their youth and as they mature.

### VITICULTURE & VINICULTURE

High quality wine doesn't come on its own. It starts in our vineyards with yield reduction, hand selection of the fruit and a variety of other biodyn-friendly measures throughout the year. In the cellar, gentle pressing is followed by traditional vinification methods. The wines are primarily fermented in traditional large barrels.

### TASTING NOTE

A German Pinot Blanc with a French soul, complex and highly finessed on the palate. Lovely toast aromas linger into a long, salty, mineral-driven finish.
