They say that you never get a second chance to make a first impression. Our ESTATE wines serve as that calling card, introducing the elegance and sense of place for which our Rheinhessen estate is known. The grapes are all grown in our own vineyards, cultivated bio-dynamically and tended by hand. They are exceptionally food friendly wines both in their youth and as they mature.

VITICULTURE & VINICULTURE

High quality wine doesn't come on its own. It starts in our vineyards with yield reduction and hand picking into small boxes. After a second sorting in the winery, the grapes get partly destemmed by hand. The fermentation takes place in traditional open vats and gentle punch downs ensure a careful extraction of the fine aromas. Aged in small French oak barrels and bottling happens without any filtration.

TASTING NOTE

A still youthful Pinot with aromas of red berries, subtle toast and accents of spice.

Dark berries - cherry - mint - spice - mineral
