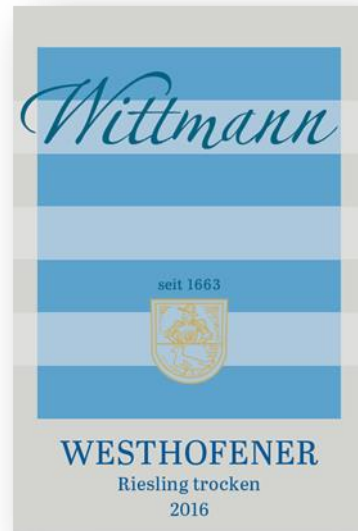

### **VDP ORTSWEIN**

Our Ortswein (village-level wines) are hand harvested from our best Westhofen vineyards, with multiple passes to select only the finest optimally ripe fruits. Deep and mineral in nature, they reflect the full potential of these outstanding Westhofen sites.

### **Viticulture:**

Intensive work in the vineyards throughout the year, low yields and rigorous hand sorting lay the foundation for top quality wine.

Our approach in the cellar tends toward the traditional, with grapes and must undergoing a gentle pressing. The wines are primarily fermented in classic oak casks.

### **Tasting Note:**

Made from carefully selected fruit from the MORSTEIN and BRUNNENHÄUSCHEN vineyards, both VDP Grosse Lagen, showcasing the traditional limestone minerality for which Westhofen is known.

Depth and a complex structure deliver notes of gooseberries, pineapple and fresh grass. A deep minerality underscores the lively, playful acidity. A long, youthful finish.
