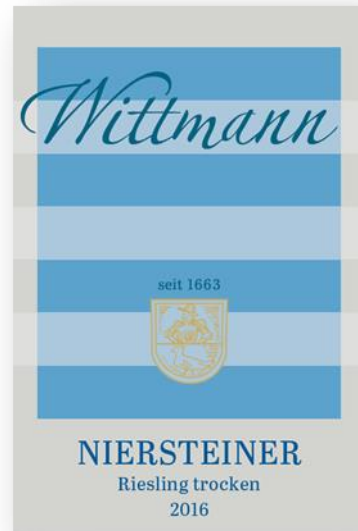
2016 Niersteiner Riesling trocken

VDP ORTSWEIN:

Our Ortswein (village-level wines) are hand harvested from our best vineyards, with multiple passes to select only the finest optimally ripe fruits. Deep and mineral in nature, they reflect the full potential of these outstanding sites.

Viticulture:

Intensive work in the vineyards throughout the year, low yields and rigorous hand sorting lay the foundation for top quality wine.

Our approach in the cellar tends toward the traditional, with grapes and must undergoing a gentle pressing. The wines are primarily fermented in classic oak casks.

Tasting Notes:

The grapes are carefully selected from the ORBEL vineyard site in Nierstein, a VDP Grosse Lage. Notes of spicy, aromatic fruit, lemon and currant. A well-integrated, refined acidity tickles the palate. Deep extract, structure and a stony minerality mark the finish.
