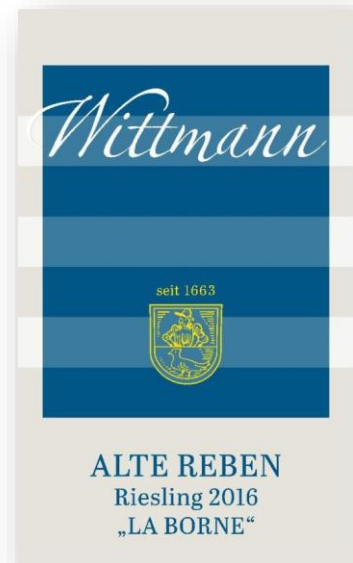


Tasting Notes

2016 ALTE REBEN Riesling trocken "LA BORNE"

Alc.: 12,5 %vol.
Residual sugar: 2,9 g/l
Acidity: 6,8 g/l



ALTE REBEN "La Borne" Riesling:

Only in very good vintages we produce the ALTEN REBEN Riesling. The wine is exclusively available at the VDP auction in Bad Kreuznach.

One of our oldest vineyards in the upper MORSTEIN profited by this condition exceptionally because of its altitude. From grapes with small berries and after a late harvest we get a highly complex wine of intensive fruit und minerality.

The elderly of Westhofen called this part of the MORSTEIN "Laborne".
If the name comes from the French "la borne" (boundary stone) or from "Born" (fountain), is not definitely clear.

Description:

Delicate fragrance consisting of 1,000 subtleties. On the palate, a sensual symphony of aromas; cool, extremely racy, refreshing spectrum of aromas. The finish lasts for minutes and its lively, light-footed, vivacious style makes it a genius of a wine.
