The grapes are all grown in our own vineyards, cultivated bio-dynamically and tended by hand. They are exceptionally food friendly wines both in their youth and as they mature.

### VINIFICATION

High quality wine doesn't come on its own. It starts in our vineyards with yield reduction, hand selection of the fruit and a variety of other biodyn-friendly measures throughout the year. In the cellar, gentle pressing is followed by traditional vinification methods. The wines are primarily fermented in traditional large barrels.

### TASTING NOTE

Voluptuous aromas of Mirabelle plum, lime and currants open this enchanting Scheurebe. Marked acidity and juicy fruit flavors linger into a long, mineral finish.
