The grapes for these ‘villages’ wines were harvested exclusively from sites rated ERSTE LAGE and GROSSE LAGE; these are wines made from very ripe fruit. Concentrated and mineral-driven, they demonstrate the potential of the top vineyards in our region.

VITICULTURE & VINICULTURE

High quality wine doesn’t come on its own. It starts in our vineyards with yield reduction, hand selection of the fruit and a variety of other biodyn-friendly measures throughout the year. In the cellar, gentle pressing is followed by traditional vinification methods. The wines are primarily fermented in traditional large barrels.

TASTING NOTE

Selected fruit from the HÖLLENBRAND vineyard (Gundersersheim), which abuts the renowned MORSTEIN vineyard (Westhofen).

Aromas of ripe yellow citrus fruits compliment freshly cut pineapple, ripe gooseberries and a delicate spice. The subtle yet racy acidity is marked with a sophisticated and mineral finish.
