VITICULTURE & VINICULTURE

High quality wine doesn't come on its own. It starts in our vineyards with yield reduction, hand selection of the fruit and a variety of other biodyn-friendly measures throughout the year. In the cellar, gentle pressing is followed by traditional vinification methods. The wines are primarily fermented in traditional large barrels.

TASTING NOTE

Selection of grapes from the best Premier Cru sites of the Roter Hang. Tropical fruit aromas such as grapefruit are enhanced by notes of white chocolate. A focused acidity shapes the long, delicate finish. The wine is marked through and through with the beautifully expressive minerality for which this red slate soil is revered.
