VDP.ERSTE LAGE

VDP.ERSTE LAGE wines come from outstanding and distinctive vineyards. VDP.ERSTE GEWÄCHSE grow there, which are characterised by longevity and individuality. Only selected grape varieties are permitted to reflect the unique character of these special sites.

VITICULTURE

The STEINGRUBE lies between the VDP.GROSSEN LAGEN Kirchspiel and Morstein and begins directly on the outskirts of Westhofen. The site was first mentioned in a document in 1295 as "dicto Stheingrube". It is characterised by limestone rocks under a thin layer of clay. Especially mineral Rieslings and Burgundies grow here.

VINICULTURE

Intensive vineyard care throughout the year, low yields and consistent selection of the grapes by hand create the basis for high wine quality. This is followed by gentle grape and must processing and subsequent traditional vinification with long yeast storage in barrique barrels.

TASTING NOTE

A Burgundian-Style Chardonnay paired with the freshness of the cooler climate of Rheinhessen.

ALCOHOL: 13,0% vol

GRAPE VARIETY: Chardonnay
