VITICULTURE & VINICULTURE

High quality wine doesn't come on its own. It starts in our vineyards with yield reduction, hand selection of the fruit and a variety of other biodyn-friendly measures throughout the year. All grapes are harvested by hand, rigorously sorted, and 100% destemmed. Traditional maceration followed with manual punch downs and gentle processing form the foundation for our sophisticated Pinot.

“This German pinot noir has a flinty nose that reminds me of youthful Corton Grand Cru from Burgundy. It too needs some time to open up, but already has stunning silkiness on the very sophisticated, medium-bodied palate.
