

2022 NIERSTEINER RIESLING TROCKEN

VDP.AUS ERSTEN LAGEN – 22115

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Wines from premier cru sites, with a long, established history. In Rheinhessen, the VDP.AUS ERSTEN LAGEN designation was introduced in 2019 for wines that serve as the finest ambassadors of their origins. They are labeled with the name of their village, whose distinctive character they reflect so authentically.

WINEMAKING

Meticulous labor in the vineyard throughout the year, reduced yields and consistent hand-selection of the grapes form the basis for top wine quality. This sets the stage for gentle processing of fruit and must, followed by traditional viniculture. The wines ferment primarily in traditional wooden barrels.

TASTING NOTES

Selection of grapes from the best premier cru sites on the Roter Hang. Enticing aromas of red currant, herbal spice and a delicate salinity. The clayey slate soils ensure a brilliant, nearly explosive minerality. Grapefruit and a fine salinity on the palate are underscored with an exacting acidity. Vibrant and concentrated with a long finish.
